Members present in the meeting: Attendance sheet is enclosed in annexure 1.


The meeting was presided over by the Hon'ble Education Minister of Assam who is also the Vice Chairman of the General Council of the Assam State Higher Education Council.

At the outset the Director of the Council welcomed the members of the General Council of the State Higher Education Council. The following issues were discussed:

1. Component wise discussion of the achievement of RUSA- 1.0
2. SHEP- RUSA- 2.0 was placed and after discussion it was approved.
3. Assam has proposed for the following components under RUSA-2.0 which were approved by the council.

8. The Chief Secretary to the Govt. of Assam who is the member of the council stressed on timely submission of utilization certificate.
9. The chairman of the meeting also further stressed for the success of the project depends not only on the money spent but also on quality monitoring and on submission of UCs.
10. He also stressed that the money goes to the proper place and is utilized properly within the time frame.
11. Vernacular medium should be encouraged in degree level colleges.

- ii. Those aspirational districts which have received a model degree college under RUSA 1.0 will not be eligible for funding consideration.
