Component No 11 Equity Initiatives (State as a Unit) Allocation -05 cr per State as Unit.

- To improve education of the most vulnerable and marginalized sections, this initiative will address State as a Unit.
- Financial assistance will be provided in addressing gender disparities, education through language labs and remedial coaching for sociallyeconomically marginalized groups
- Girls' Hostels and related support will be given priority

Punjab is applying for three Girls' hostels in Colleges which fall in the rural backwards areas with an enrollment of more than 1000 girl students each, namely GC Malerkotla, GC Sunam and GC Nabha.

The State also proposes to establish a language lab in Urdu at GC Malerkotla and a Language Lab in English at GC Tanda Urmur in addition to introducing remedial classes for students lagging behind in studies in all the Govt. Colleges.

Component 12 Faculty Recruitment Support

Eligibility Criteria

 Priority will be given to those States which have filled all their vacant sanctioned positions. After filling the positions, RUSA would assist the States in hiring additional faculty to bring the Student Teacher Ratio to 20:1

RUSA
RUSA may support faculty positions in new institutions created under RUSA, only after the State fills all the vacant positions (upto 85%) through regular recruitment and brings the STR to 25:1.

There is a stay on recruitment of regular faculty in Punjab as per the orders of Hon'ble Punjab and Haryana High Court. The State is making all out efforts to get the same vacated. Regular recruitment will be undertaken as soon as the stay is vacated. Meanwhile keeping in mind the interests of students, all sanctioned vacant faculty positions have been filled up by guest faculty who fulfill the required conditions laid down by the UGC.

MHRD is requested to provide faculty in the eligible Govt and the following four institutions created under RUSA 1

- Govt Professional Arts and Sports College Jalandhar
- Punjab State Aeronautic Engineering College Patiala
- Model Degree College, Ferozepur
- 4. Model Degree College Pathankot

Component No 13 Faculty Improvements: (Allocation Rs. 7 crores)
