Sir,

I am directed to refer to the approval of the competent authority to release an amount of Rs. 4,05,00,000/- (Rupees Four Crore Five Lakh Only) as 2nd & final installment of Preparatory Grants, 3rd & final installment of infrastructure grants to one college and 1st instalment of infrastructure grants to one college at the central: state share of 90:10 to be incurred to the State Government of Arunachal Pradesh under Rashtriya Uchchatar Shiksha Abhiyan (RUSA). Under the initiative under reference, the Central Government shall provide assistance to the State Governments for various components, which are mentioned as per the guidelines under RUSA.

- In accordance with the instructions of the Department of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance, Government of India, vide D.O.No.32/PSO/FS/2015 Dated 28th October, 2015 for Special Category States, the funding pattern Arunachal Pradesh comes under the Special Category States. 2nd & final installment of Preparatory Grants, 3rd & final installment of infrastructure grants to one college and 1st instalment of infrastructure grants to one college at the central: state share of 90:10 to be incurred to the State Government of Arunachal Pradesh under Rashtriya Uchchatar Shiksha Abhiyan (RUSA) amounts to Rs.4,05,00,000/- (Rupees Four Crore Five Lakh Only). Further installments of the allocation shall be released by the Ministry only after the State Government concerned releases its committed share towards non-recurring expenditure and recurring grants, besides submission of the Utilisation Certificate by the State in respect of the installment of the Central grant released.
- 3. The sanction is issued in exercise of the powers delegated to Ministries under DFPR, 1978, as amended from time to time. Above grants are being released in accordance with the pattern of Assistance approved by the Ministry of Finance, Government of India. It is also certified that this Sanction is being issued in conformity with the rules and principles of the scheme.

On receipt of sanction letter, the Principal Accounts Officer may issue an advice to the Reserve Bank of India (Central Accounts Section), Nagpur for affording credit of the sanctioned amount to the balance of the State Government. - 7. Accordingly, I am directed to convey the sanction of the President to release an amount of Rs. 3,13,87,500/- (Rupees Three Crore Thirteen Lakh Eighty Seven Thousand Five Hundred only) as the General Component of the 2nd & final installment of Preparatory Grants, 3rd & final installment of infrastructure grants to one college and 1st installment of infrastructure grants to one college at the central: state share of 90:10 to be incurred to the State Government of Arunachal Pradesh under Rashtriya Uchchatar Shiksha Abhiyan (RUSA).
- 8. The Expenditure of Rs. 3,13,87,500/- (Rupees Three Crore Thirteen Lakh Eighty Seven Thousand Five Hundred only) will be debited to Demand No.58-Department of Higher Education from: Major Head 3601 Grants-in-aid to State Government, 06- Centrally Sponsored Schemes 101- Central Assistance/Share, 33-National Education Mission: Rashtriya Uchchatar Shiksha Abhiyan (RUSA), 01-Rashtriya Uchchatar Shiksha Abhiyan (RUSA), 31-Grants-in-aid-General, of the financial year 2017-18.
- 9. A certificate of actual utilization of the grants received, for the purpose for which it was received, should be submitted to the Ministry within 12 months of the closures of the financial year.
