

Brief on Chandigarh

- The ratio of central funding for Chandigarh is 100 percent
- Under RUSA 1 :
 - a) Rs 26 crore were approved. Total Central share approved Rs26cr.
Out of this 19.99 has been released as part of Central share.
Approvals: for Infrastructure grants to 10 colleges
- Under RUSA 2:
 - a) Rs 20 crore has been approved out of which total central share is 100 percent so far Rs. 10cr. has been released.
 - b) Approvals: 4 colleges for infrastructure grants, 1 HRDC for Faculty improvement and for equity to the UT as a unit.
- Combined RUSA 1 & 2 :
 - a) **Total amount approved Rs. 46 crores** whole of which is the **central share** **The amount released** so far is Rs.29.99cr.

Major Issues:

1. The UT needs to strengthen and expand the SPD and SHEC offices.
