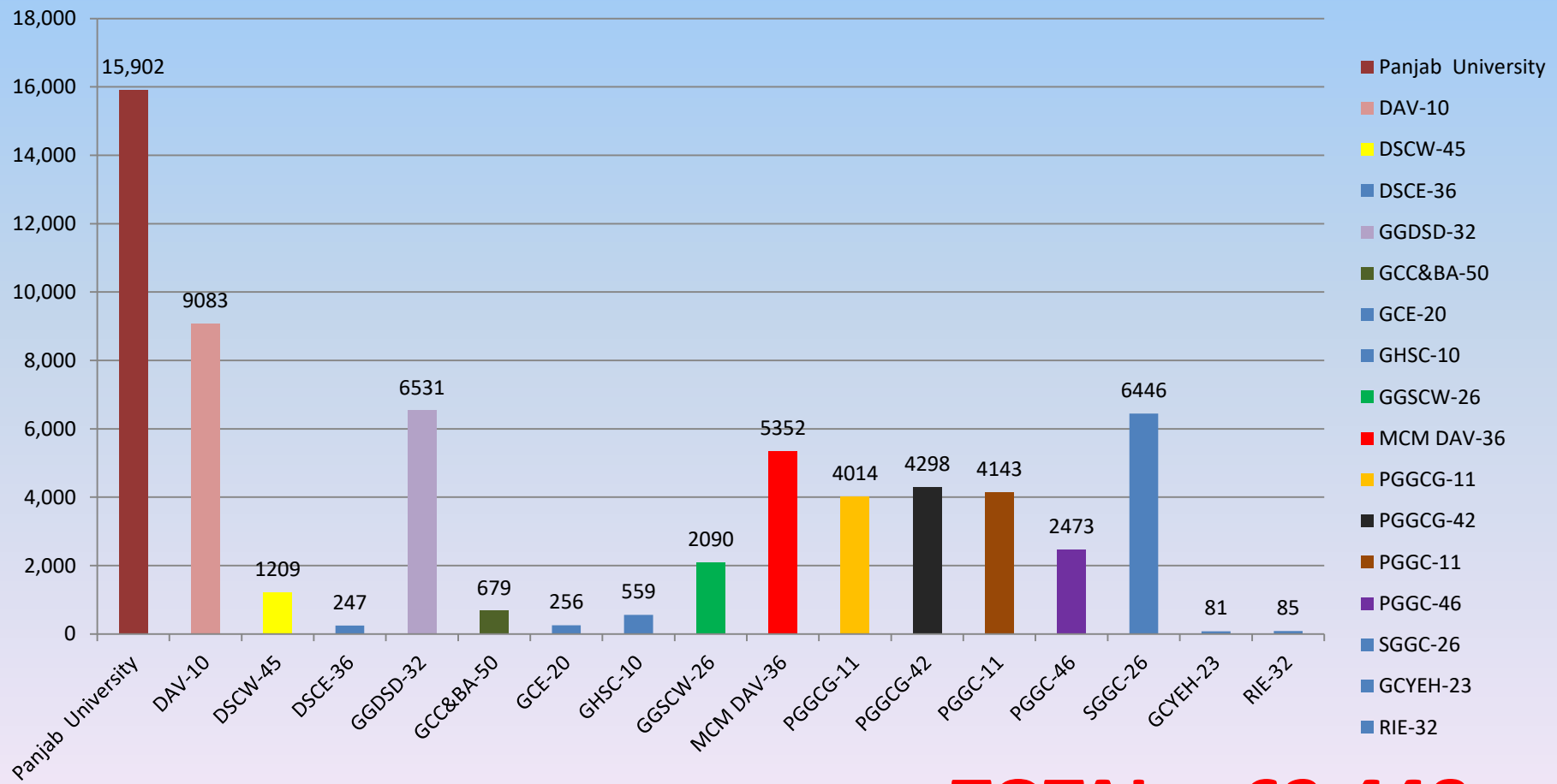

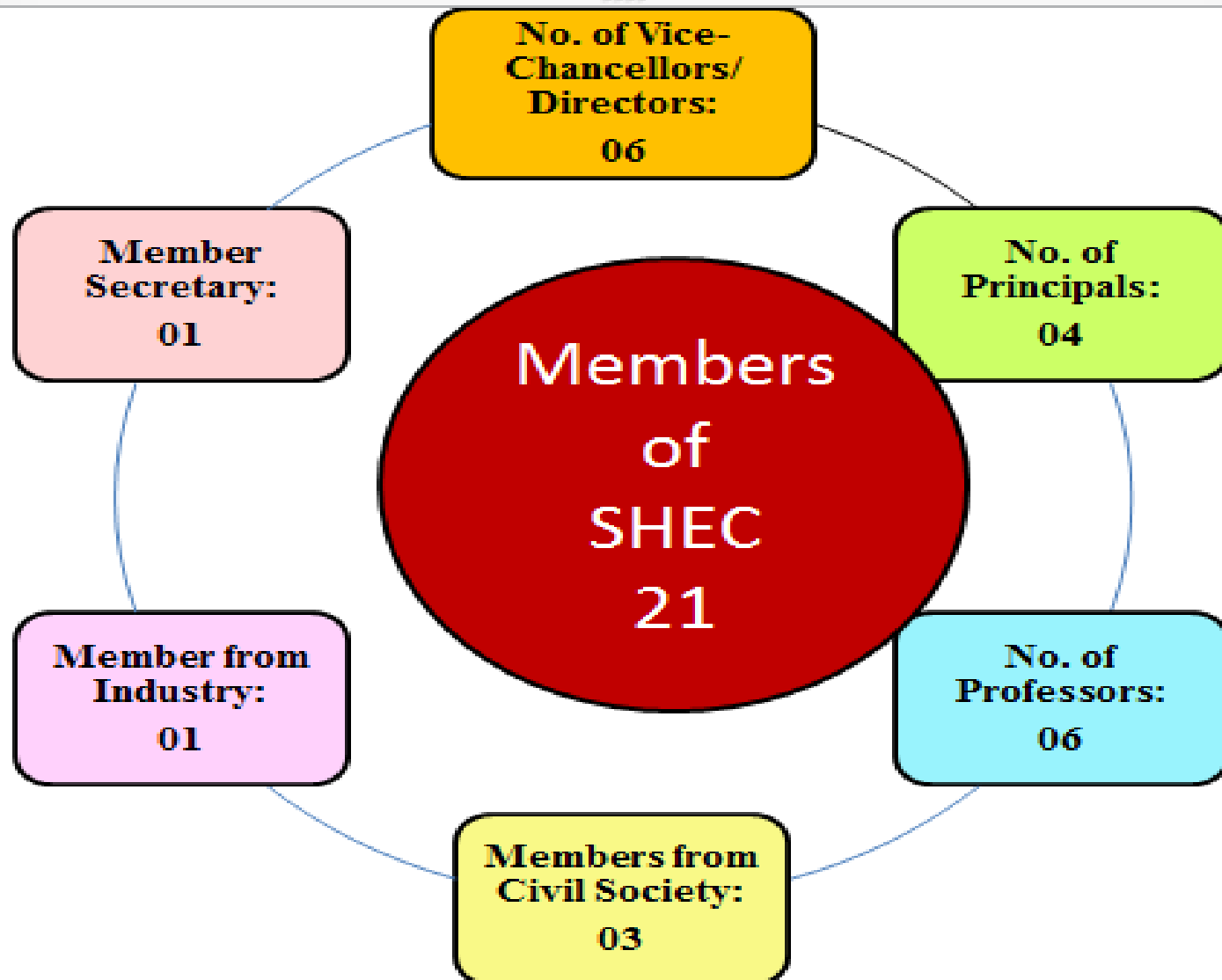
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# STUDENT ENROLLMENT STATUS OF UT, CHANDIGARH (2016-17)

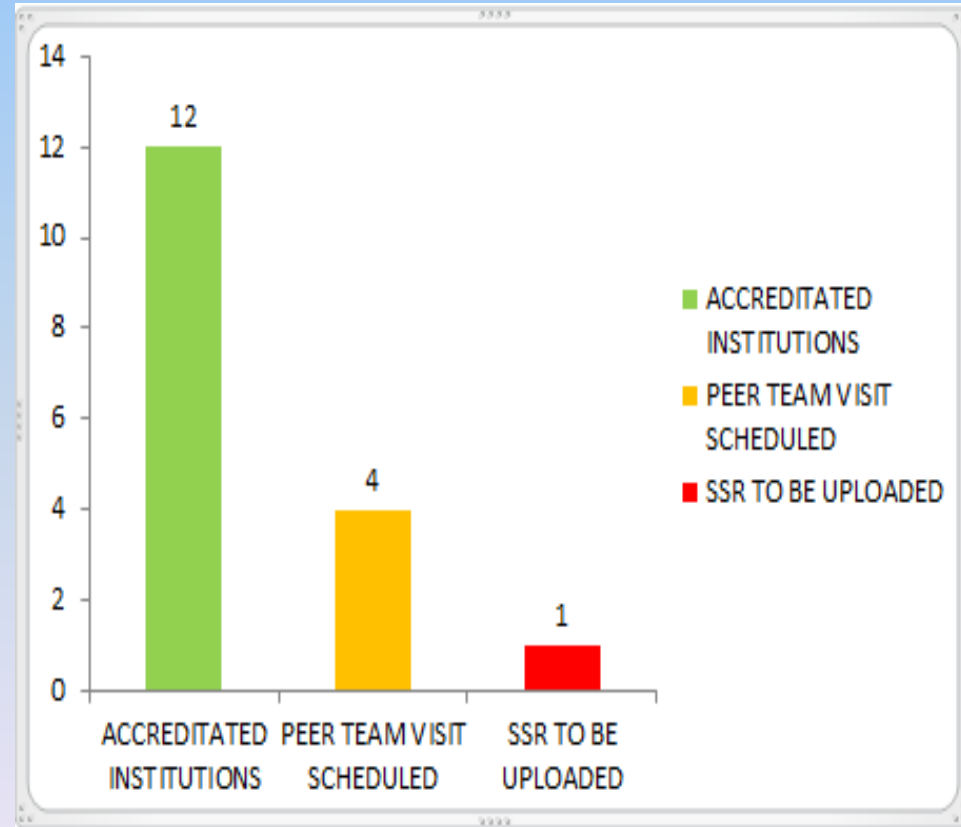
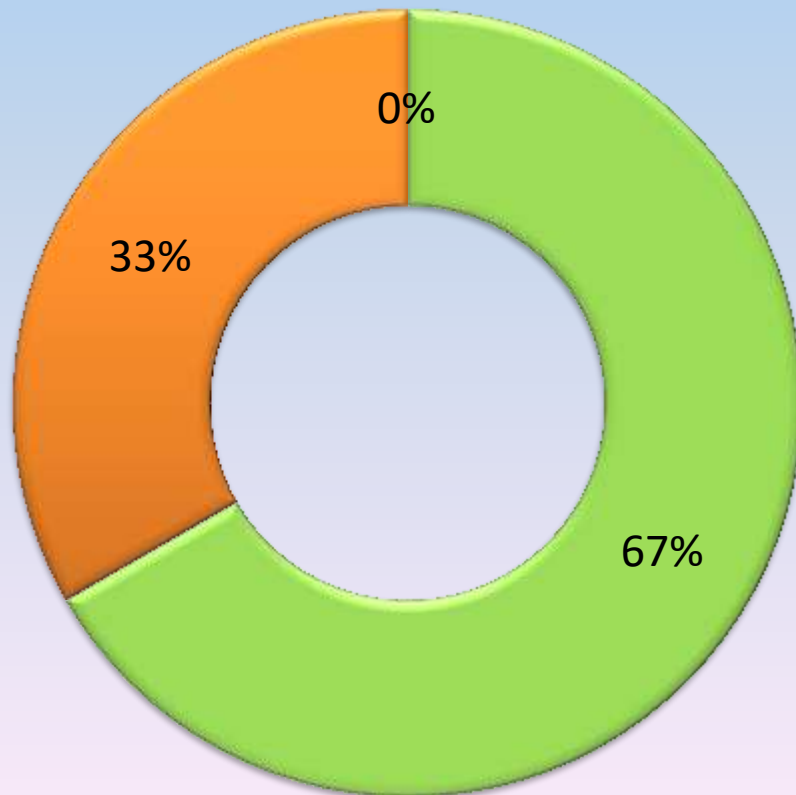

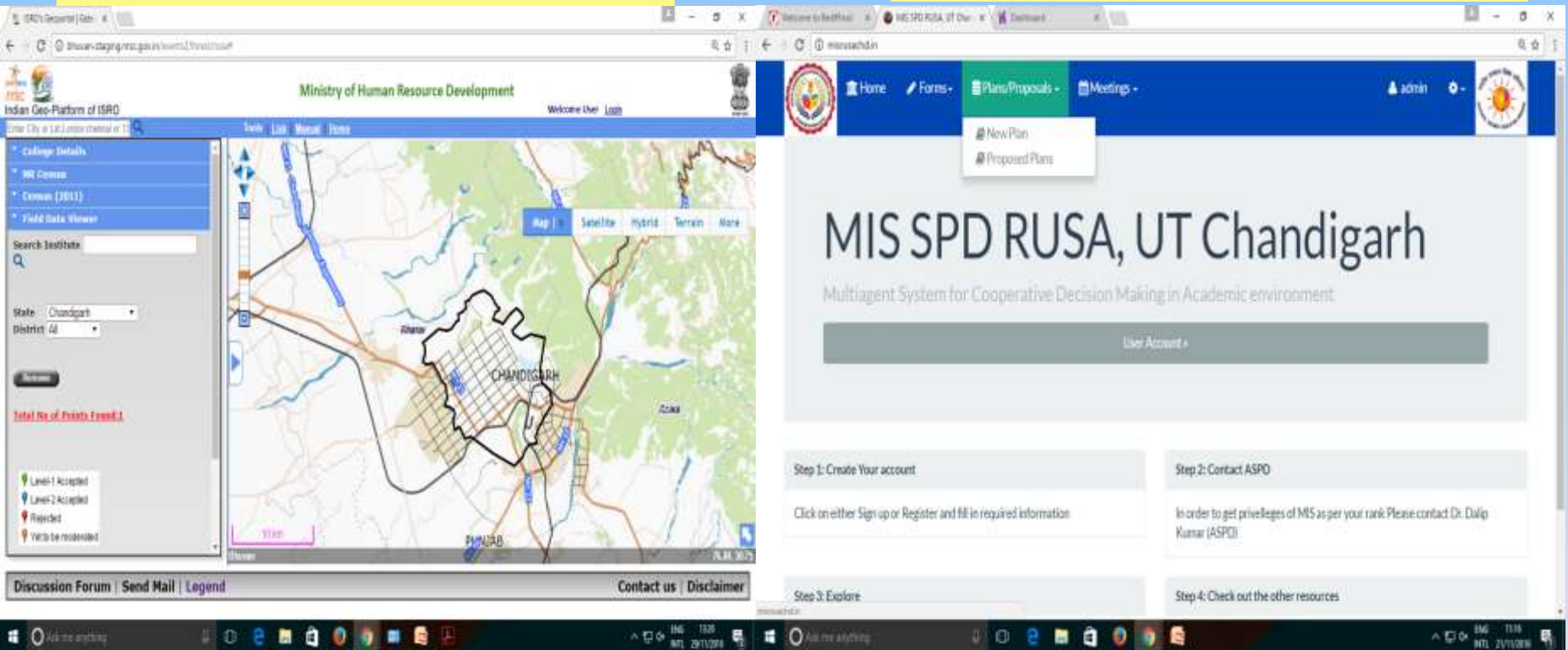

The workshop saw 120 participants from Panjab University, PEC, NIPER, IMTECH and affiliated colleges of the city deliberating on various issues.

Professor Binu Dogra, principal of the college, in her introductory address, highlighted the aims and objectives of the workshop and mentioned PFMS as one of the mandatory requirements of Rashtriya Uchchatar Shiksha Abhiyan (RUSA). Dr Dalip Kumar, ASPD (RUSA), elaborated that such programmes would be organized frequently for better awareness and understanding of the issues initiated by

MHRD under RUSA scheme for affiliated institutions in Chandigarh.

S Francis, senior accounts officer (expert trainer for PFMS RUSA), ministry of finance, in a lucid and informative participatory discussion, detailed the various dimension of PFMS and provided hands-on training on the occasion. He said the PFMS provides the scheme managers a unified platform for tracking releases and monitoring their last mile utilization.

Keeping in view the need to improve the financial management, the government has decided to universalize the use of PFMS to cover all transactions/payments under the central, states and UT schemes. Professor Punam Agarwal, RUSA coordinator, while conducting the event emphasized that PFMS is an important tool for improving governance and transparency.

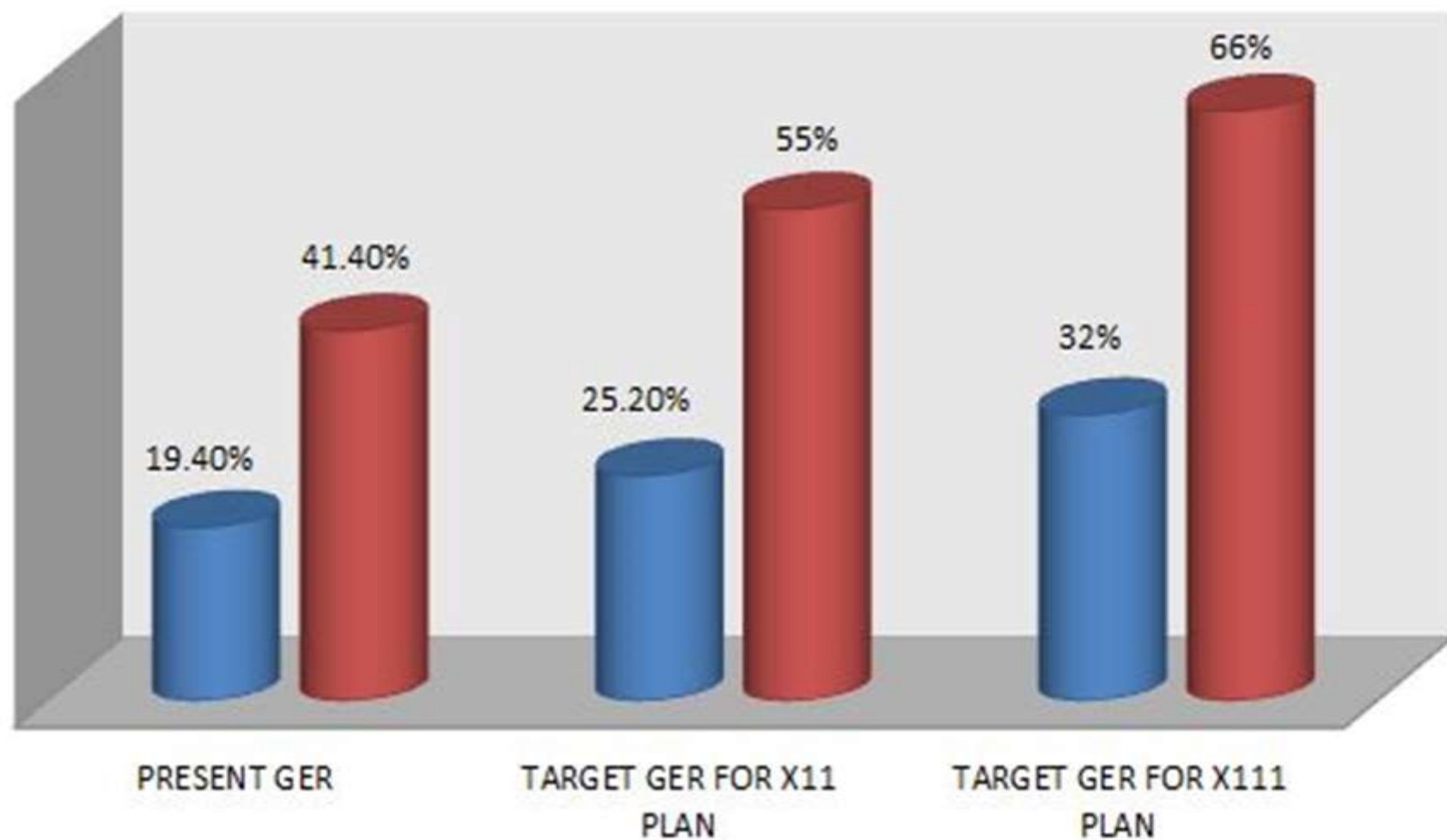
