# III. Compliance to Reforms:

## 1. Constitutions of the State Higher Education Council

- The Gujarat Higher Education Council Bill -2016 is already passed by the legislative Assembly. Now it is under further process.

## 2. State Projects Directorate

- The SPD has been formed with notification of the Commissioner (HE) heading the same as State Projects Director, along with 9 other members, dated 26<sup>th</sup> February, 2015.

### **3. Scale up Financial Contribution to Higher Education as % of GSDP to reach RUSA prescribes Levels**

- Yes, Total 2756 Colleges has implemented CBCS at UG Level and total 1237 Colleges has implemented CBCS at PG Level as per information provided by institute in AISHE Survey. It means 100% implementation of CBCS

## **5. Governance Reforms**

- The Gujarat Higher Education Council Bill -2016 is already passed by the legislative Assembly. The University Acts have been amended from time to time. Future amendments will be done as per the requirements of the State and guidance provided by UGC & MHRD.

## **6. Affiliation Reforms**

- Government has already instructed Universities and colleges not to give permanent affiliation without NACC accreditation .

## **7. Filling Faculty Vacancies**

- Recently Government filled up 480 post of Assistant Lecturers & 110 Principal posts in Grant in aid colleges.
- 554 Assistant Lecturers and 52 Principals appointment process is being conducted by GPSC.

## **8. Accreditation Reforms**

- The Quality Assurance department is already established by GOG in the year 2010. The documents and Report had already been submitted to RUSA Consultant
- In Gujarat 457 Colleges and 18 Universities are accredited in NAAC.
- LOI has been accepted by NAAC of 34 Colleges & 2 Universities till date.
