# Reforms under RUSA

## 1. Implementation of CBCS

CBCS was introduced in all (34) Autonomous Colleges from 2015-16 .During 2016-17,all the Colleges have adopted CBCS. Further ,all the 08 Model Degree Colleges are functioning from this season 2016-17 under CBCS mode.

## 2. Affiliation Reforms

- New Universities have been set up under RUSA project. R.D .Women's College has been up-graded in to an affiliating University . Forty-six (46) affiliating Women's Colleges have been separated from Utkal University and have been put under R.D Women's University to lessen the burden.

## 3. Examination Reforms

- E-valuation of answer scripts

Use of C.C TV in examination centre to supervise the examination process.

#### **4. Establishment of State Quality Assurance Cell and impact on Accreditation**

The SLQACC in Odisha was established on 29.07.2002. Due to the establishment of SLQACC, Improvement reflects in terms of Accreditation

# Best practices adopted by the state under RUSA

- **Opening of different Cells in all Universities and Colleges:**
- All Vice-Chancellors of Universities and Principals of all Colleges have opened Students Advisory Bureau, Career Counselling Cell, Placement Cells, Internal Quality Assurance Cell, and Equal Opportunity Cell.
- **Capacity Building development programmes:**
- Leadership development programmes have been organized under RUSA for the Vice-Chancellors/Registrars/other officials of Universities and also for Principals of Colleges
- **Vice-Chancellors' Conclave:**  
All the Vice-Chancellors of State funded Universities meet once in every two months to discuss on important issues pertaining to Higher Education and suggest the Government to take remedial measures.

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- **Implementation of e-Scholarship:**
- Different types of Scholarship are awarded to students pursuing higher studies by the Higher Education Department. In order to make the process easy, it has made on-line for application /selection/renewal and disbursement. 24,544 students have been benefitted. Interest subsidy will be given to the students, availing study loans from the banks.
- **Implementation of Green Passage Scheme:**
- As per the scheme, orphan students pursuing higher education from Plus-II level to post-graduation level, will no longer have to bear the education expenses.
- **Kalinga Siksha Sathi Yojana :**
- Government of Orissa has introduced a very unique educational loan scheme for the students who are financially weak and want to pursue their higher education. This educational loan scheme is named as the **Kalinga Siksha Sathi Yojana** and it will provide the education loan at only 1% interest rate.

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- **“Vyasakabi Fakir Mohan Senapati’ Scholarship for promotion of Odia Language:**

To promote Odia language,the Govt. have instituted a scholarship named after Vyasa kabi Fakir Mohan Senapati in 2016 .This is available for the students passing B.A.(Arts) with Odia as Honours/Major subject securing more than 90% marks in the Degree Examination, conducted by State Universities and Autonomous Colleges of Odisha. This is a one time scholarship of Rs 20,000/-only.

- **Personnel Information Management System(PIMS)**

- PIMS has been launched in 2016-17. The detailed information of staff members of colleges will be captured in PIMS.
