Governance Reforms:

All the institutions have established a Board of Governors.

The Equal Opportunity Cell, Grievance Redressal Committee, Placement Cell, Anti-Ragging committee etc. are formed to address the concerns of the students, parents and others.

Academic Reforms:

All the institutions in the UT of Puducherry offer the courses only in Semester System.

The Choice-based Credit system is introduced in all the autonomous colleges and the colleges affiliated to the Pondicherry University(a Central University) will introduce the CBCS system from 2017-18 academic year

The updating and revision of the curricula in all the autonomous colleges are carried out once in every three years and the colleges affiliated to Pondicherry University are done as and when the University revise the curricula.

Admission Procedure:

Centralized admission procedure is followed separately for all the professional Colleges (CENTAC) and Region-wise for Arts & Science Colleges (CAPASC)

Examination Reforms:

Continuous Internal Assessment (CIA) is followed in all the UG and PG Courses in the University, Professional Colleges and autonomous colleges and in PG courses only in other institutions.

The Weightage assigned to Internal Evaluation is 25-40%

The end semester evaluation is by a written and practical examination and the CIA is also added.








Proposed Construction of Second Floor of ECE & CSE Block Puducherry University of Technology



Proposed Construction of Second Floor of EIE & IT Block Puducherry University of Technology




Proposed Up-gradation of T&P Block Puducherry University of Technology






